AIM OF THE CONGRESS

In this 2-day course, the participants will deepen their knowledge about the role of the environment on mental health.

A first part of the course will be dedicated to the natural environment, in particular to the influence of air pollutants and meteorological variables on mental health, with a focus on Major Depressive Disorder.

Subsequently, social determinants, such as traumatic experiences or refugee status, will be explored.

The course will also represent the opportunity to return some of the main findings of the DeprAir project, funded by Fondazione CARIPLO, which will formally end on February 28th, 2024.
